Motion by Chairman Miner to adopt Res. 2023-4, approving an application for loan funding through the Fayette County Infrastructure Bank Application program for a match (\$44,503.59) for the Hawthorne Street Small Water and Sewer grant and a match (\$46,228.80) for the Multimodal Fund Grant (Francis Avenue Sidewalks), contingent upon grant approval; also including the Shultz Street project (drain issues and road resurfacing) (\$22,400.00). Motion by Chairman Miner to adopt Res. 2023-5, intent to reimburse general funds/ARPA funds or short-term borrowed funds used to construct improvements on Shultz Street and to match funds for the Francis Avenue Sidewalk project and Hawthorne Street Small Water and Sewer Project with funds received from the Fayette County Infrastructure Bank. 2nd by Supervisor Hann. All in favor, motion carried.
