ORDINANCE NO. 2024 -1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CONNELLSVILLE, FAYETTE COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ARTICLE VII – PROHIBITIONS, SECTION 701 A and B
(Prohibited Discharges and Connections) OF
ORDINANCE NO. 2017-5, ALSO KNOWN AS THE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE

**IT IS HEREBY** ordained and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Connellsville Township, Fayette County, as follows:

## SECTION I. AMENDMENT

This Ordinance hereby amends Section 701-A and B, Prohibited Discharges and Connections, Ordinance No. 2017-5, also known as the STORMWATER MANAGEMENT Ordinance, as follows:

## SECTION 701 A and B. WILL NOW READ AS FOLLOWS:

- A. Any drain or conveyance, whether on the surface or subsurface, that allows any non-stormwater discharge including sewage, process wastewater, wash water, grass clippings, yard waste or other debris to enter a regulated small MS4 or to enter the surface waters of this Commonwealth is prohibited.
- B. It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly cause grass clippings, leaves, or other debris or waste produced in conjunction with yard maintenance or gardening onto the streets, alleys, and other publics roads of the Township of Connellsville. A homeowner is responsible to ensure that any persons hired to cut their grass or maintain their yard abide by this ordinance. Any grass or waste which inadvertently is caused to enter the streets or alleys of the Borough shall be promptly removed; there is no "grace period" within which to remove grass or leaves.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by law.
